COACHING POSITION



Ski Mountaineering Competition Canada is welcoming applications from interested and qualified persons to act as the National Team Coach. The goal of this position is to assist SMCC with fielding the strongest possible National team for international competition.

Duration: this is expected to be a two year commitment, starting immediately after a World Championship season concludes. This first cycle will begin in January 2021 and extend until the end of the 2023 season.

Responsibilities:

- Coaching and race support at World Championships including equipment prep, course review, and race planning
- Provide all National Team athletes with quarterly meetings (in person or via phone) to advise on planning their training and preparing for the season/competition
- provide coaching assistance and supervision to all participants at National Team Training Camps as requested by camp organizers
- organize one yearly training camp for team members in BC or Alberta
- Input on selection policies and competition team selection
- Input on junior development

Compensation: this is an unpaid position at this time. Travel expenses to certain events, training sessions, and competitions may be reimbursed at the discretion of SMCC (the best strategy to allocate travel funds to be discussed between the coach and the SMCC committee).
